June 16-19, 2020, Belgrade, Serbia

The 24th International Symposium in the Field of Pulp, Paper, Packaging and Graphics is organized by the Center for Pulp, Paper, Packaging and Graphics Industry of Serbia and the Faculty of Technology and Metallurgy in Belgrade, under the patronage of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia and the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Serbia.

The main goal of this symposium is to gather experts engaged in pulp, paper, packaging and graphic industry, as well as representatives of academic institutions and, with the assistance of foreign lecturers (representatives of international companies), to deliver information about new technologies, as well as new operations and processes in existing technologies, which could enable price cuts and quality improvement of products, followed by better preservation of the environment.
